Down will come baby, cradle and all.

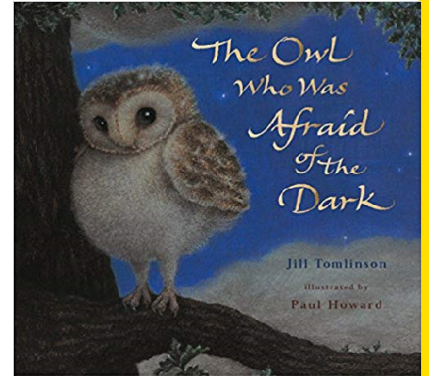
